Service officers can also assist you in obtaining temporary assistance (if eligible) via the Soldiers', Sailors' and Marines' Fund for the following purposes: Weekly assistance, Assistance with rental payments or mortgage interest payments, Assistance with utilities such as gas, electricity, water and home heating fuel, Assistance with medical expenses, Assistance with emergent dental care, Prescription medications, Eye examination and eyeglasses, Audiological evaluation and hearing aids, Funeral expenses and Durable medical equipment.
